Camps Leelanau and Kohahna Policy Statement

Men and women applying for staff positions at Camps Leelanau and Kohahna realize that they will be serving as role models for campers while carrying out demanding responsibilities. The desire to be a staff member requires an enthusiastic dedication to the camp activities and a commitment to teamwork with the other staff members. It also brings a position of trust, and those who apply for a position on the staff must fully realize the importance of living up to this trust. The following are our policy standards and if there is any question or concern with these standards, please discuss your concern with us prior to applying.

1. To faithfully study and apply daily the teachings of Christian Science to all functions of the camps.
2. Staff will refrain from the use and verbal support of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, any form of drugs, and profanity while under contract with Camps Leelanau/Kohahna.
3. Staff shall not participate in any sexual activity outside of marriage and will avoid the appearance of inappropriate activity.
4. Staff will maintain a clean and neatly groomed personal appearance, be appropriately dressed, and keep their living and activity areas neat and orderly.
5. Staff will give their undiluted attention to their responsibilities to the camps when on duty or when acting on behalf of the camps.
